
# ADVANCED PLACEMENT COURSES

- AP Courses are college-level courses offered in high school.
- Courses reflect what is taught in top introductory college courses.
- Students can register to take AP Exams at the end of the course in May, measuring their mastery of college-level work.
- Students will receive a 1, 2, 3, 4, or 5, with a score of 5 being the highest.
- A score of 3 or higher on an AP Exam can typically earn students' college credit and/or placement into advanced courses in college.



# AP CREDIT POLICY

• Each college and university has its own policies regarding AP credit and placement.



### AP EXAM ADMINISTRATION

- AP Exams are administered by schools worldwide on College Board arranged dates in May each year.
  - Exams range in length between 2-3 hours
  - Multiple Choice & Free Response
- Standardized testing requires students and proctors to adhere to strict policies and procedures as outlined in the AP Bulletin and the College Board website.
- Exam dates and times are **not** moveable. Students with overlapping exams should contact Ms. Osborn and indicate the overlap on their registration form. Students will be notified of which exam they will be taking during the latetesting administration.

### DIGITAL EXAMS

- Computer Science Principles
- English Language (11th grade English)
- European History
- Addition exams will be announced soon.
- Proctored and administered in school on the same schedule as paper exams. (They may not be taken at home.)
- Same number of sections, number and type of questions, and timing.
- Students can go back within a section to review/complete questions.
- Students practice with the Bluebook Testing App on their district-owned laptop or their personal device.

## 2024 EXAM REGISTRATION PROCESS

- In each AP class during the month of September students will be provided with an access code to access the course specific AP Classroom portal
- Students will need a CollegeBoard.org account.
- CollegeBoard.org accounts are created by students, not by PAHS.
- Please only have one College Board account, if a student is unable to log in, please contact College Board directly. (See next slide.)
- All students are required to join into each AP Course in AP Classroom they are enrolled in

# 2024 EXAM REGISTRATION PROCESS STEP #1

#### STEP #1: DECISION ON COLLEGE BOARD

- By November 1, 2023, each student is required to select whether they ARE or ARE NOT taking the specific course exam in May 2024.
- All students must complete this step for each AP Course they are enrolled in. The default status is "undecided."
- By selecting YES to taking an exam, the student is agreeing to be billed for the cost of the exam.

# 2024 EXAM REGISTRATION PROCESS STEP #2

### STEP #2: PAYMENT

- Exam cost:
  - \$98 per standard exam
  - \$146 per Capstone exam (Research & Seminar)
  - \$20 per exam for student who qualifies for the National School Lunch Program
- See next slides for payment information.

### **PAYMENT PROCESS: NEW THIS YEAR**

- Between the November 1<sup>st</sup> decision deadline and November 15th, the bill per exam will be added to Skyward Student Fee and made payable as a bill in SchoolPay
- After November 15, families can log into SchoolPay to pay the fee for each exam
- Payment is due by March 1.
- The exams will be listed individually with the assigned price.
- There is a service charge (1.75%) on SchoolPay.



# LATE FEES

- For any student who registers for an exam **after** November 1, a \$40 late-fee will be added in the total per exam cost. No exams can be ordered after March 1.
- Refunds per exam will be made to students who cancel their exam between November 1 and March 1 (all by \$40 will be refunded).
- No refunds will be provided after March 1.
