The SAT is a globally recognized college admission test that lets you show colleges what you know and how well you can apply that knowledge. It tests your knowledge of reading, writing and math.

\*Phoenixville Area High School is a testing center for the October 2023 exam. The October exam is the last paper and pencil exam that PAHS will offer.

\*\*College Board has started the transition to digital exams only. All SAT exams will be digital starting with the March 2024 exam and moving forward.

College board has implemented the following SAT identification requirements to ensure test integrity:

- ALL test takers must have an admissions ticket on test day.
  - o If the student arrives at their test center without their admissions ticket, they will be turned away.
- ALL students must upload a photo of themselves when they register online.
- In addition to their admissions ticket, on the test day ALL test takers must have acceptable ID: driver's license, passport, or school ID.
  - If the student does not have a photo ID to go along with their admissions ticket they will be turned away.
  - Unacceptable ID: credit card, social security card, birth certificate
- Students needing to change their test date, must do so prior to the late registration fee dates listed above. These changes must be made directly with College Board and there is a fee to make changes.
- Students must be extra cautious when entering their birth date when registering. If they make an error and show up on test day, and their birth date doesn't match their ID, admission ticket or the centers roster- they will be turned away.
- Beginning with the March 2024 exam, all SAT exams will be digital. Please review the digital exam information.
- The Counselors do not have access to the student's College Board user names and passwords. Students must write these down so that they can view their scores and/or register for another exam if needed.
